Collection and Use of Your Data

PintAid use and keep the information you provide about yourself and about third parties in order to provide the services that you have requested, for fraud prevention and to communicate with you for marketing purposes.

PintAid will process this information and store it on our computer and manual record systems.

By disclosing your personal data to Pint Aid, you indicate your consent to the collection, storage, processing and use of this data by Pint Aid as described in this Privacy Statement.

Disclosure

At Pint Aid.ie ,we consider your personal data to be private and confidential however from time to time we may disclose your information, in confidence to:

- Agents or service providers we have appointed
- Or as required by law

Right of access, rectification or deletion of your personal data

Use of Cookies

A cookie is a small amount of data, which often includes a unique identifier that is sent to your computer browser from a website's computer and is stored on your computer's hard drive. Pint Aid records visits to our website and uses browser cookies in order to monitor your progress through our site.

This information is used by us to measure the performance of the site and to generate other statistics about visitors to our web site in general. We may also use this data to make the site easier and more convenient to use.

No personal data is stored in the Cookie and cannot be used to identify an individual user. Cookies do not in any way compromise the security of your computer.

Users can set their computers to accept all cookies, to notify them when a cookie is issued, or not to receive cookies at any time. If you set your computer not to receive cookies, this will mean that some websites will not function and certain personalised features cannot be provided to you.

How is your Information Secured and Protected?

We are committed to protecting the security of your personal information. We use a number of security procedures and technologies to assist in protecting your personal data from unauthorised access, alteration, use, disclosure, accidental loss or destruction.
